## Tour Programme

			Overnight
<b>Sat 21 April</b>	<b>Naples</b>	<b>L</b>	<b>NAPLES</b>
	<i>We begin the tour in Naples with a light lunch, followed by an introductory tour walking through the Historic Centre in the afternoon.</i>		
<b>Sun 22 April</b>	<b>Campi Flegrei, Cumae</b>	<b>B L</b>	<b>NAPLES</b>
	<i>The morning is spent exploring the other-worldly landscapes of the Phlegrean Fields, including a still seething volcanic crater. We then take you to Cumae after lunch, the most ancient Greek settlement on the Italian peninsula.</i>		
<b>Mon 23 April</b>	<b>Certosa di San Martino</b>	<b>B L</b>	<b>NAPLES</b>
	<i>Our focus returns to Naples with a visit to the monastery complex of San Martino to see its sumptuous Baroque church and the extraordinary collection of nativity scenes. The afternoon is left at your leisure with unlimited free travel on local public transport.</i>		
<b>Tue 24 April</b>	<b>Pompeii</b>	<b>B L</b>	<b>SORRENTO</b>
	<i>This morning is dedicated to Pompeii, possibly the most famous ancient Roman town second only to Rome itself. After this is lunch at the very entertaining "University of Pizza" in Vico Equense, before we transfer to Sorrento.</i>		
<b>Wed 25 April</b>	<b>(Day at leisure)</b>	<b>B</b>	<b>SORRENTO</b>
	<i>The day is left free to let you to savour Sorrento the way it should be done – without a schedule to limit your enjoyment of arguably Europe's most famous seaside resort.</i>		
<b>Thu 26 April</b>	<b>Capri</b>	<b>B L D</b>	<b>CAPRI</b>
	<i>Today we transfer to the legendary island of Capri, holiday playground of the rich and famous from Roman emperors to Hollywood stars, and it will be very easy to see why this is so.</i>		
<b>Fri 27 April</b>	<b>Villa San Michele</b>	<b>B</b>	<b>CAPRI</b>
	<i>This morning we take a short walk from our hotel to visit Villa San Michele, the former home of Swedish doctor and author Axel Munthe, where you can enjoy some of the most dramatic panoramas of Capri. The afternoon is at your leisure, so if the weather allows perhaps you might like to make your way to see the incredible Blue Grotto?</i>		
<b>Sat 28 April</b>	<b>Positano, Amalfi</b>	<b>B D</b>	<b>AMALFI</b>
	<i>Our boat from Capri shall take you to Positano, passing spectacular coastline along the way, and from here we continue on to Amalfi to stay for the next three days. A guided walk is planned for the afternoon before our dinner.</i>		
<b>Sun 29 April</b>	<b>Day at leisure</b>	<b>B</b>	<b>AMALFI</b>
	<i>This day is left free to let you to relax. Walk the quaint streets, attend mass at the Cathedral, visit the beautiful town of Ravello by bus or just read a book lounging on the beach if you feel like it. The more adventurous can attempt to walk the trails hugging the spectacular coast.</i>		

<b>Mon 30 April</b>	<b>Paestum</b>	<b>B D</b>	<b>AMALFI</b>
	<i>Today we take you south of the Amalfi coast to visit a dairy farm to taste the exquisite mozzarella freshly made from buffalo milk. Paestum is scheduled for the afternoon, site of an ancient Greek city with some of the best-preserved Doric temples in Europe.</i>		
<b>Tue 1 May</b>	<b>Mount Vesuvius</b>	<b>B L</b>	<b>NAPLES</b>
	<i>We leave Amalfi today to visit the immense crater of Mount Vesuvius, mainland Europe's highest and most active volcano, where on a clear day you can enjoy a magnificent view of the Gulf of Naples. An early lunch is forseen in a village along the way.</i>		
<b>Wed 2 May</b>	<b>Herculaneum</b>	<b>B L</b>	<b>NAPLES</b>
	<i>Herculaneum is the focus of the morning, one of ancient Roman towns buried during the volcanic eruption of Vesuvius in AD79. The afternoon is left at your leisure with unlimited free travel on local public transport.</i>		
<b>Thu 3 May</b>	<b>Reggia di Caserta</b>	<b>B L D</b>	<b>ROME</b>
	<i>This morning we visit the Royal Palace and Gardens in Caserta, a UNESCO World Heritage Site often used as a setting in movies, before we head for Rome for our final night of the tour.</i>		
<b>Fri 4 May</b>			
	<i>Transfer will be provided after breakfast this morning from your hotel to the airport.</i>		



### Note

1. Travel insurance is required for all tour participants.
2. Complimentary transfer is provided from Rome and/or Fiumicino Airport on 23 April 2016 starting no later than 9am. Please contact Ergo: Travel for details.
3. Comfortable walking shoes are strongly recommended as there will be substantial walking on both paved and unpaved ground, sometimes on steep slopes or extensive steps.
4. Optional walks may be offered during free days without additional charge.
5. While weather in Southern Italy is generally mild at this time of year, participants are advised to take along protective outerwear in case of rain.
